NRA Basic Pistol Class went ONLINE FEB 2016

NRA Pistol Shooting Course is now ONLINE. The online portion is called Phase 1 and costs the student \$60. *Instructor Candidates must also pay \$60 to the NRA for Phase 1.*

The Basic Pistol Course PACKETS WILL NOT BE AVAILABLE TO INSTRUCTORS after May 15, 2016. Students will come to you after they do the online portion for you to do PHASE II of the Basic Pistol Course. Go to <u>www.NRAINSTRUCTORS.org</u> and download the PHASE II course plan.

I did work with the Kentucky State Police and John Howard several weeks ago to have the online course approved but the cost is prohibitive for Kentucky due to the DOCJT \$75 cap.

- 5) Classroom is at the 'L' in the building


