# KY HB 417 PASSED AND SIGNED BY GOVERNOR PER KY LRC EFFECTIVE JUNE 29, 2017

KY HB 417 makes two major changes for KY CCDW.

- > Replaces student gun cleaning requirement in DOCJT classes with an Instructor Demonstration
- > APPROVES USCCA AND NSSF CLASSES AND INSTRUCTORS IN ADDITION TO NRA
  - DO NOT TEACH ANY OF THE ABOVE COURSES UNTIL I SEND INFORMATION THAT THEY
    ARE APPROVED BY KSP
    - I am coordinating with KSP to get these classes approved ASAP and will send out a PRESS RELEASE as soon as they are approved.

- Strong side hip holster fitted leather or kydex or similar material MUST COVER TRIGGER/TRIGGER GUARD
- Quality belt designed to carry a holster and a firearm securely
- Quality factory new ammunition suitable for practice minimum 300 rounds 4
- Minimum of two (2) spare magazine or speed loaders with appropriate pouches
- 6. Clothing appropriate for concealed carry
- 7. Eye Protection - minimum Z87
- Ear Protection preferably electronic 8.
- 9. Cover garment
- 10. Clothing for any weather

To develop the knowledge, skills, and attitude to carry and use a concealed pistol ethically, responsibly, and with Objective:

**Description:** The course is at least 8 hours long and is conducted by an NRA Training Counselor and NRA Instructors in a

classroom and at a shooting facility.
